ABSTRACT

The main objective of this research paper was to investigate the relationship between social media usage and employees' job performance at Bank Rakyat located in Bangsar, Kuala Lumpur. This research paper also aims to determine the impact of social media usage on employees' job performance. Questionnaire was being used as the instrument to collect data needed in order to complete this research paper. SPSS V-26 was used to analyze the questionnaire in order to determine the findings of the research. 63 out of 75 employees of Bank Rakyat were chosen as the respondents in the research conducted.
