ABSTRACT

Malaysia is one of the developing countries in Asia. Economic stability helps Malaysia in making decision or organized their savings as it usually used as an indicator of country's overall strength and wellness. Unfortunately, National savings performance in Malaysia still indicates low level of saving rate compared to other developed country such as China. Savings provide the most important economic relationship between historical, current and future performance in a country. Sufficient percentage of national savings is regards as basics condition for achieving targets in the investment and growth rates. Keeping in the view of importance and role of national savings in macroeconomic stability suggested that government should improve the level of national savings for sustainable and debit free economy by considering the significant variables from experimental exploration of this study.
