CHAPTER 1: INTRODUCTION

As the leading state agency entrusted with the responsibility of taking the lead in spear heading Sarawak's economic development and generating wealth for the state, PELITA has successfully established itself as a premier player in several important economic sectors such as tourism, property development and plantations.
