ABSTRACT

This study was to determine the factors of occupational stress that influence work performance among secondary school teachers in Seremban. A survey using questionnaire approach to 214 of secondary school teachers in Seremban was used. The respondents were chosen using the cluster sampling. The instrument used consists of two sections of questionnaires which consisted of demographic profiles and factors of occupational stress that influence teacher performance. This research addressed fifth main purpose, which are: (1) to identify the demographic of teachers in Seremban secondary school; (2) to determine the occupational stressor among secondary school teachers in Seremban; (3) to examine the level of stress among secondary school teachers in Seremban; (4) to compare the level of stress in a sample of male and female teachers; and (5) to examine the stress differences between male and female teachers for each stress factor. This study utilized descriptive analysis and independent sample t-test analysis. This study also found that demographic variables of : (1) gender; (2) age; (3) race; (4) marital status; (5) highest academic qualification; (6) length of teaching experiences; and (7) monthly salary. The study also highlighted five factors of occupational stress are: (1) student characteristic; (2) school environment; (3) administrative procedure; (4) condition of service; and (5) teacher characteristic.
