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INTEGRATING ZAKAT INSTITUTIONS INTO THE MAINSTREAM ECONOMY: EVIDENCE FROM MALAYSIA

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Abstract

Zakat is a significant tool in economic growth whereby zakat acts as poverty eradication instrument, income redistributive device and a stabilization mechanism. Zakat is also recognized as a pioneer instrument of the world welfare system in human history.
