CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Introduction

The construction of long-awaited 17km bridge linking the mainland and Labuan may soon become a reality. The Labuan-Menumbok bridge is a new planned bridge which connecting Labuan Island and Menumbok in Sabah, Malaysia. This bridge was first mentioned in the Labuan Development Plan (1997-2015) during the time Tun Daim Zainuddin was Finance Minister. The bridge is expected to be build up to 17 kilometer and enough to accommodate motor vehicles and thus Labuan was in urgent need of the link. (Skyscapercity, 2009, Jan 14)

The proposal to build a bridge between Labuan and Menumbok will be studied under the 10th Malaysian Plan. It was proposed that the bridge is going to be build from Tanjung Aru in Labuan to Membakut at Sabah, while for the estimated cost is to be around RM 550 million. The feasibility study on the bridge is being undertaken by Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) and the government has allocated RM5 million for the study and it is expected to be completed soon. (Skysrapercity, 2009, January 14) Furthermore, the construction for the proposed bridge is expected to be beneficial not only for Labuan and Sabah' peoples, but also for neighboring Sarawak and Brunei.

In order to make this research more meaningful, the perception of locals in Labuan is really important and crucial to take into government consideration before the construction of the bridge is started. Perception is the process of attaining awareness or
