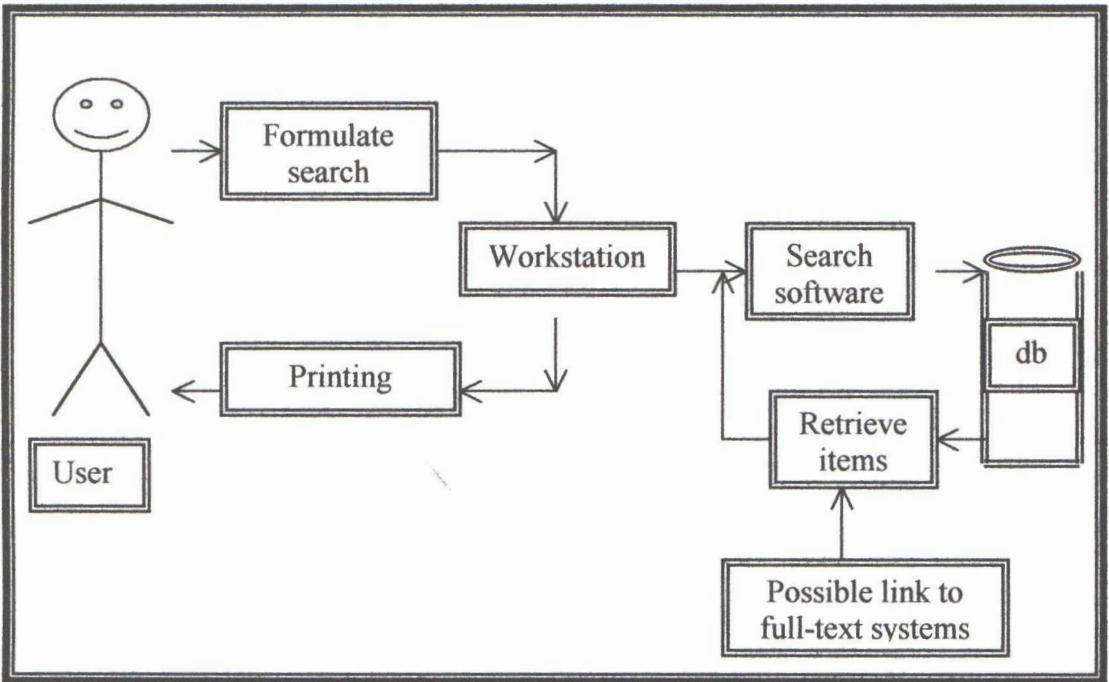


Fig.1: Basic elements of an online database searching
