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



Collagraph printmaking is an art form where prints are made by printing from a plate constructed on either mount board or a very thin plywood. The artwork is made up like a collage, hence the name Collagraph. The collagraph is a relief printing technique whereby the raised surfaces of a material are printed. First thing that comes to mind is the materials. Each material has its owncharacteristic and plays a vital role in the outcome of this work.

The materials used in this artwork are packaging of items used daily such as canned drinks, tissue boxes, toothpaste tubes, etc. The plate construction is a no-cost consideration.
