# **CHAPTER 1 INTRODUCTION**

## **1.1 INTRODUCTION**

Since there are still have poverty cases and is increasing in Malaysia, people question where does Zakat money goes? Zakat payer tends to have issue on Zakat management and this will bring problems towards Jabatan Agama. This issues may be affect some zakat institutions. According Khaleequzaman , there was one interview that been done and they found out that zakat distribution is still failed to distribute to the asnaf. There are also zakat left over in every institution that was not be distributed(Khaleequzzaman et al., n.d.)

## **1.2 PROBLEM STATEMENT**

Zakat is distributed by an organization in Jabatan Agama called the Amil. They are the one that responsible to distribute Zakat's property. Muslims are compulsory to fulfil the third pillar of Islam. After zakat payer had paid, Zakat will be distributed to Asnaf.

In order to distribute Zakat, The Amil must identify potential asnaf. To track the asnaf requires many resources on the Jabatan Agama part as it involves manpower, time and money. Not much help can be expected from society either, because the society does not get direct access to the Amil to delivery information. However, The assumption of the inefficiency of managing zakat also is one of the problem which it has led to a negative perception of zakat institution among society, such as zakat payers and zakat recipients(Khaleequzzaman et al., n.d.).Moreover, According to Khaleequzaman, "There are many controversial debate among society complaining about the method distribution of the zakat because there are still more poverty problems within them (Khaleequzzaman et al., n.d.)." Therefore, This has somehow affected the trust of zakat payers to the extent that some have chosen to pay zakat directly to the asnaf without going through the zakat centres.(Saad et al., 2017). Jabatan Agama needs to take action in order to improve efficiency of Zakat distribution and attainment of social justice among the community(Saad et al., 2017) Moreover, to ensure the potential asnaf received Zakat. This application will make Jabatan Agama's work easier and efficient as they can tracked those who need and can change the community perspective.
