ABSTRACT

The higher education sector in Malaysia is under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of the Higher Education (MOHE). Various Malaysia's higher educational institutions currently house an estimated 942,000 students of which about 50,000 are international students from more than 100 countries.

Besides providing a good high educational standard, at a relatively low cost, in Campus University facilities were also one of the factors influencing people including foreigners to choose which universities they will go to.
