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ABSTRACT

Safety climate can be described as individual perceptions and understanding towards the value of safety in the work environment. In an organization, safety climate refers to employees' thoughts about the organization's movement on safety in their workplace and towards Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) issues. In Jabatan Kerja Raya Pulau Pinang, safety has become one of the main issues that influences employees and their surrounding workplace. A research has been done on The Perception of Safety Climate towards Safety Attitudes among Employees in Jabatan Kerja Raya Pulau Pinang.
