DEFINITION

Facilities Management

Facility management is an interdisciplinary field primary devoted to the maintenance and care of large commercial or institutional buildings, such as hotels, resorts, schools, offices complexes, sports arenas or convention centers. Duties may include the care of air conditioning, electric power, plumbing and lighting system, cleaning, decoration, grounds keeping and security. Some or all of these duties can be assistedby computer programs.

Preschool

Preschool is a school for the education of verv young children (generally five years of and younger). These age schools seek to prepare young children before enrolling schools with formal education, they only provide childcare with educational little benefits. Preschool which focus education generally teach early skills social including interpersonal interaction, being a part of a group of peers, and skills such classroom following the instructions of a teacher.

METHODOLOGY

PRIMARY DATA

Observation

Interview

This process has been carried out with the Assistant Director (Operations) I, KEMAS Selangor

Questionnaire

Questionnaire will be distributed to (6) six respondents of each preschool chosen at random consisting of teacher, assistant preschool, and parents.

SECONDARY DATA

Secondary data is collecting and possibly processing data by people other than the researcher in question. Common sources of secondary data are Social science surveys and data from government agencies, Including Local authority agency.

CASE STUDY

- Establishment and management of KEMAS Preschool are through the responsibility and cooperation between KEMAS and society
- KEMAS preschool is divided into two types that is provided and managed entirely by the KEMAS and another one is rental or contribution from the society.
- As stated in the scope of study, case study is selected preschool located in Selangor. Six (6) case studies have been chosen for this dissertation.



KEMAS Preschool Baitul Iman and Sek 8 have the highest percentage in the provision and satisfaction towards the facilities provided. Two (2) units preschool that management under KEMAS entirely, this has been proven that preschool under KEMAS management have the provision and satisfaction towards facilities is very good.

Different with four (4) units of preschool is **KEMAS Preschool** Sek 2, Sek 7, Baitul Hakim and Baitul Usmaniah, Preschools management of this preschool is managed by society, so the provision and satisfaction towards facilities rather limited. Problems also arise because of inadequate financial allocation for the preparation of a comfortable and safe facility

To proposed the solution for the problems that involved facilities at preschool.


INTERVIEW

QUESTIONNAIRE




Level of Facilities Management Services at Preschool



Majority of respondent from each case study said that planning and management of allocation is good except KEMAS Preschool Baitul Usmaniah and Baitul Hakim


KEMAS Preschool Sek 2, Sek 7 and Baitul Iman, majority of respondent opined on sufficient of facilities provided is good and the majority of respondent in KEMAS Preschool Sek 8 opined it was very good. Majority of respondent in KEMAS Preschool Baitul Usmaniah and Baitul Hakim considers sufficient of facilities provided is poor.






Majority of respondent in each preschool opined safety of facilities provided were good except KEMAS Preschool Sek 7. Majority of respondent in this preschool opined it is very good because has a committee that is concerned about the safety of students and teachers. This preschool is equipped with facilities that according the guideline set up by KEMAS

KEMAS Preschool Sek 8, all of the respondent considers strategy for up-to-date facilities are good, while different from two other preschools that are KEMAS Preschool Baitul Hakim and Baitul Usmaniah. Majority of respondent's opinion towards strategy for up-to-date facilities are poor.




Respondent Opinions Towards The Facilities Management Services.



Majority of respondent opined facilities management each preschool is a necessary but differ **Preschool KEMAS Baitul** Usmaniah. All of the respondent in this preschool opined facilities management is very necessary the condition because preschool is a relatively poor

Majority of respondent in KEMAS Preschool Baitul Iman and Sek 7 considers it necessary, while in KEMAS Preschool Baitul Usmaniah, Baitul Hakim and Sek 2 because for the three preschool is under the management of society.



PROPOSED SOLUTION

- * KEMAS should outline to set up level of benchmark of each preschool to achieve high level of effectiveness for total facilities management by facilities provided at preschool. KEMAS the need to continuously monitoring the facilities available at each Preschool to ensure that each preschool has adequate facilities as well as a complaint or report from preschool management.
- KEMAS also should be ensure before each establishment application for new preschool under the society management approved, facilities provided must meet the stipulated guideline. If the facilities provided are inadequate and not as guideline set, then the establishment of a preschool will not be approved by the KEMAS.
- Some of unsatisfied facilities were influenced by lack of maintenance by management. The routine maintenance, preventive maintenance should be plan by maintenance schedule to achieve goal of facilities management. The aim should be provide real time support to occupant such as increase the maintenance crew from KEMAS.
