In keeping with its mission to enhance language scholarship and excellence, Academy of Language Studies, Seremban campus organized a 3 series webinar which was held on the 21st January, 28th January and 4th February, 2022 respectively. The purpose of these webinars was to showcase The Academy of Language Skills by introducing the services offered and the skills and expertise available. Besides that, these webinars were also to highlight the third languages that are offered such as the Arabic and Mandarin languages. These webinars were also carried out to expose the academic and administrative staff of UITMNS, Seremban Campus staff, to the correct pronunciation and usage of words in the English Language, Arabic and Mandarin languages. The focus was on the commonly mispronounced and misused words and phrases in daily conversations and conversely. increase the understanding of different cultures among Malaysians.

Announced as "Coffee and Tea with APB Seremban", this is the first time APB has conducted a series of 'chill out and chitchat' webinars. These webinars were conducted in an informal roundtable chit-chat fashion, rather than the usual serious academic-like seminar, featuring a panel of speakers comprising lecturers from APB Seremban, who shared and exchanged their expertise, experiences

and knowledge. The Opening ceremony was officiated by the Head of Academy of Language Studies, Associate Professor Zainon Ismail.

Each webinar was carried out over a duration of two hours, covering various topics such as Malaysian vocabulary and phrases related to travel, and abbreviated food, social media language SMS (short in message service). The participants o f the webinars also shown were analyze the lyrics of English songs and were exposed to errors commonly found on signages and notices. In addition, they also learnt how to greet, order food or utter short exchanges and phrases in the Mandarin and Arabic languages.
