5.1 Proposed Executive Summary

Despite the contributions of waqf to the society at large, there are some issues related to waqf specifically from local perspective. Amirul Faiz, Htay and Mustafa Omar (2012) viewed that the response of Malaysians towards cash waqf is still lacking. Hence, the study is conducted on a desire to understand the factors that influence the intention to participate in cash waqf among individuals in Malaysia by utilizing Theory of Planned Behaviour (TPB). A structured questionnaire using a seven-point scale was employed to collect the data. The items from previous studies are modified to adapt into cash waqf context. The questionnaires were distributed to students and staff of Universiti Teknologi MARA Kelantan Campus, Malaysia. The results obtained from the data collection will identify whether the three independent variables (attitude, subjective norm & perceived behavioural control) have significant relationship with the intention to perform cash waqf. As such, TPB framework will explain the intention to perform cash waqf among individuals in Malaysia, specifically the students and staff in UiTM Kelantan Branch.
