Waste is for the most part contributed by the construction industry. There's growing importance in the techniques to limit waste at construction sites. This study aimed is to apprise building professionals with other alternatives to sustain the use of existing supplies of materials for recycling and level of awareness among construction professionals about these. The usage of Recycled Aggregate Concrete (RAC) paves new ways for reusing materials in the building industry. Making use of Recycled Aggregate Concrete (RAC) can provide a solution for excessive waste materials as long as the final product fits the standard quality required.
