





Sukan Malaysia 2022

Sukan Malaysia 2022 athletic events were held from 15 - 18 September 2022 at the Bukit Jalil National Stadium Kuala Lumpur. The 2022 SUKMA Games, officially known as the 20th SUKMA Games and commonly known as MSN 2022, was a multi-sport event that was originally scheduled to be held in Johor in July 2020. Due to COVID-19 and MCO, the event was postponed and later hosted by Kuala Lumpur.

AP Dr. Hoe Foo Terng, a senior lecturer from the Mandarin Unit, Academy of Language Studies who is also a qualified national grade 1 track and field KOAM (Malaysia Amateur Athletic Union) technical officer since 2004, was

appointed as a track judge by Majlis Sukan Negara Malaysia. His involvement in athletics began in 1996 in Selangor. He has also served as a technical officer in other sporting events such as the SEA Games 2017, Penang Bridge Marathon, MSSM, and MSSPP.

There were 44 events in the 2022 SUKMA Games. A total of 132 medals were up for grabs. Johor was crowned the overall champion, with 9 gold, 6 silver and 7 bronze. The 1st runner up was Sabah with 7 gold, 8 silver and 3 bronze. Sarawak became the 2nd runner up, securing 5 gold, 4 silver and 6 bronze. Penang was ranked 8th and obtained 2 gold.
