

THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN TEACHERS' PRE
SERVICE TRAINING AND TEACHERS' PERFORMANCE

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ABSTRACT

Teachers' pre service training is the training provided by government to the perspectives teachers so that they can learn about the skills and knowledge about teaching from professional educators, then they can practice it in actual classroom teaching and learning process. The variables chose to describe the relationship of teachers' pre service training and their performance is relate to the purpose of attending pre service training before being able to teach in class.
