#### **CHAPTER 1: INTRODUCTION**

### 1.0 <u>INTRODUCTION</u>

### 1.1 BACKGROUND OF STUDY

Pekan town is a town in Pekan Pahang Darul Makmur that located around 44 kilometre from Kuantan and about 380,500 hectares. There are eight *mukim* in Pekan Pahang which are Pekan, Kuala Pahang, Pahang Tua, Pulau rusa, Lanngar, Lepar, Penyor, and Bebar (RTD, 2015). One of the main attraction of Pekan town is the historical place and landmark that give strength to the physical characters of the place such as Istana Sultan Abu Bakar, Museum Masjid Sultan Abdullah, Museum Sultan Abu Bakar, and Museum Kapal Pulau Beram. They preserve the old commercial building built since 1920 and still being used until now. It continues to lose its own urban identity. There are several action taken by the Local Authority of Pekan Pahang such as proposed Pekan River Front but it does not effectively express the identity of Pekan
