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ABSTRACT

Piano interpretation is an important playing style for interpreting pieces of music. Indeed, it is intended to add to the knowledge of the appropriate method of interpretation for as elected work. This study is an investigation into the framework and characteristics of the interpretation of piano pieces during the Baroque period. To refine the investigation, my research focused on the relevant characteristics of the performed parts that I specifically identified as Dynamic, Pace, and Pronunciation for "Prelude No. C minor, BWV 847". This study also explains a brief comparative history between the Baroque period and the modern period, because it is important to know the history of Baroque music before the music of the Baroque period is forgotten.
