MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN UNIVERSITI TEKNOLOGI MARA, MALAYSIA AND NATIONAL DONG HWA UNIVERSITY, TAIWAN, R.O.C.

In the spirit of international understanding, <u>Universiti Teknologi MARA</u>, <u>Malaysia</u>, and National Dong Hwa University, Taiwan, R.O.C., agree to examine the possibility of establishing a framework for educational and research cooperation for our students, faculty and staff.

In preparation for establishing a formal framework for future activities, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. Explore possibilities for faculty and staff exchanges for research, lectures, and discussions that mutually benefit both institutions;
- 2. Explore the feasibility of student exchanges and study programs;
- 3. Seek support for projects determined to be mutually beneficial to both institutions:
- 4. The terms of joint activities and arrangements for specific visit, exchanges, and other forms of cooperation will be agreed upon in writing prior to the initiation of any activity. Any commitment of resources, financial or otherwise, in support of these activities must be contained in subsequent specific agreements;
- 5. While no binding commitments have been made, we sign this Memorandum of Understanding in recognition of our common interests and agree to consult periodically concerning the status of our collaboration;
- 6. This Memorandum of Understanding will come into effect on the date when the representatives of both institutions affix their signatures to the Memorandum of Understanding and shall be valid for a period of three years. The validity of the memorandum may be extended after discussion by representatives of both institutions, and such discussion shall be commenced not later than six months;
- 7. The Memorandum of Understanding may at any time be revised or modified within that period by mutual consent. It may be terminated within the period by either party giving six month written notice to the other;
