Students are encouraged to question the information provided in the financial statements, adjust the figures, if necessary, and use these information in analyzing any organization. In addition to the analytical tools necessary to carry out the detailed analysis, students are expected to be able to know and apply the theoretical framework that forms the basis of financial statement analysis.
