And Student Excellence Ceremony, Faculty of Pharmacy

On May 24, 2023, the Academic Office, Faculty of Pharmacy organised the Dean's Awards and Student Excellence Ceremony at Lecture Hall 7, FF4 Building.

The ceremony aimed to celebrate students who received the Dean's Awards during February 2023 examinations and also recognise students for their excellent achievement in co-curricular activities. A total of 16 students from the Bachelor of Pharmacy (PH240) program received the Dean's Awards, and one student from the Master in Pharmacy Practice (PH772) program received the Faculty Postgraduate Award.

To be eligible for the Dean's Award, students must have obtained a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.50 and completed at least 12 credit units of courses with grades in a semester, as stated in the Academic Diploma and Bachelor of UiTM (Amendment 2021). For the Faculty Postgraduate Award, students should have achieved a Grade Pointer Average (GPA) of 3.75 and above for a particular semester based on the total number of credit units mentioned in the study plan, according to the Academic Rules and Regulations for Masters and PhD by Coursework and Mixed Mode (Amendment 2022).

The ceremony commenced with a welcome speech by Dr. Aida Azlina Ali, Deputy Dean (Student Affairs), who represented the Dean of the Faculty of Pharmacy. Dr. Mohd Shahezwan Abd Wahab, Deputy Dean (Academic Affairs), then presented the certificates to students who received the Dean's Awards and Faculty Postgraduate Award.

During the ceremony, special recognition was also given to Madam Siti Hajar Mahamad Dom, a student from the Master in Pharmacy Practice (PH772) program, who received the Faculty Postgraduate Award as the Best Student. She was invited to deliver a speech.

Following that, Dr. Aida Azlina Ali, Deputy Dean (Student Affairs), presented medals to students who actively participated in co-curricular activities. These students had won gold, silver and bronze medals in various categories, including Ultras, Volleyball, Archery, Aerodance, Orienteering, Futsal, Netball, Chess, Tennis, Badminton Doubles, Petanque and 200m events in the Interfaculty Sports Championships and the National Pharmacy Sports Carnival (NPSC) Programme.
