How to make a Pinata

A pinata is a figure-shaped container made with paper. The figures can be shaped like virtually anything imaginable and are hollow on the inside so that they can be filled with toys, candy and other treats. Pinata will be hung up at parties or celebrations. It will be hit with a stick by children until it is broken and the things inside fall out.

To create a pinata, below are the materials needed:

Foil/Latex Balloon (any shapes)
Colourful papers/crepe papers
Scissors
Glue
Newspaper
Candies/treats
Strings
Stick



Steps to make Pinata:

- 1 Blow out the balloon. Cut newspapers into strips and glue them until it covers the balloon. Cover the balloon with layers of newspaper stripes. Wait until the glue dries.
- 2 Cut out 4cm wide strips of brightly coloured crepe paper using scissors. Fringe the stripes. Glue the coloured papers layer by layer with different colours onto the balloon. Wait until the glue dries.
- 3 Next, make a hole under the bottom part of the balloon. Insert chocolates, sweets/candies, cookies or other treats into the balloon. Close the hole with layers of newspapers and coloured papers.
- 4 Finally, to make your pinata look nicer, cut the colourful crepe papers into strips and fringe it to decorate the side or top of the pinata. Tie a string on top of the pinata to hang it.
- 5 To make the stick of the pinata, cut the colourful crepe papers into stripes and fringe it. Glue the stripes onto the stick until the stick is fully covered with colourful crepe papers.
- 6 **Now, it's time to have fun!**
