All this beauty is not without a price. Sadly, not everyone can
afford it. In a recent study by a group of university students, it was found that some students have resorted to counterfeit cosmetics because they were more affordable than the originals.

More importantly, the students were unable to differentiate between the counterfeit and original cosmetics. Regrettably, too, they decided to buy after an assurance by the salesperson that many customers had bought counterfeits.

Even more dangerous, the salesperson claimed that the counterfeits were as good as the originals. Some buyers were
even told that the cosmetic products they bought were originals that were rejected by the manufacturers.

In the study, a majority of the respondents, aged between 21 and

30, were found to be aware of the sale of counterfeit cosmetics in the market. However, they were not aware of the contents of counterfeit cosmetics.

The majority also did not know how to check the authenticity of a cosmetic product and they would buy the product if its quality was close to the original.

The danger is that this attitude would promote the continuous
sale of counterfeit cosmetics. Its ingredients could contain toxins that could be harmful to the skin and body.

There is no money back guarantee for such products either. Thus, although every woman wants to look beautiful, one should ask oneself whether using counterfeit cosmetics is worth all these risks?
