## **ABSTRACT**

The purpose of this study was to study the relationship between types of workload and stress level among secondary school teachers in 'Maktab Rendah Sains MARA Kuantan'. The study focused on secondary school in 'Maktab Rendah Sains MARA Kuantan'. The questionnaire was used to investigate the correlation of types of workload and stress level among secondary school teacher. The questionnaire was distributed randomly in the secondary schools. The school was selected to provide a correlation to types of workload and stress level due to the workload. The study also wanted to identify whether extreme workload of secondary school teachers contributed to stress level. In this study, the workload was identified into three aspects which were academic, co-curriculum, and special task.
