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CHAPTER 2

2.0 LITERATURE REVIEW

2.1 INTRODUCTON

Over the last decade, in both developed and developing countries, issues relating to academic achievement have received the attention of researchers and policy makers. Great efforts were made to identify the relationship between study skills and academic achievement of the students. The research carried out thus far can be broadly grouped into two categories that are the factors affect studies and the effectiveness of study methods.

2.2 THE EARLY STUDIES

One of the most useful concepts to appear in the area of students learning has been that of approaches to learning. In early studies of how students read a passage of text, Marton and Saljo (1976, 1984) found two characteristics approaches that students adopted, one group focused on the words used, and attempted t remember particular words or phrase of the author. The other focused on the author's meaning and tried to make sense of the passage, relating it to their own understanding.

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
