The Accounting Research Institute (ARI) is a leading institute granted the status of Higher Institution Centre of Excellence by the Ministry of Higher Education Malaysia (MoHE). It is a renowned global research centre in Islamic Financial Criminology.

Its mission is to enrich the knowledge corpus in Islamic Finance and Financial Criminology through quality research, innovation and consultancy endeavours, mainstreaming talent excellence, empowering community outreach, and promoting financial sustainability that is impactful for society.

The institute also boasts of well-established postgraduate programmes with an international student population. The programme provides the opportunity to combine advanced research studies with professional experience. The structure enables students to gain knowledge and confidence in academic research through supervisory teams and effective modules.

Various research activities at ARI have quintuple helix impact. In the year 2021 and 2022, ARI was entrusted by several government agencies to develop the national action plans. This includes National Action Plan on Preventing and Countering Violent Extremism (NAPPCVE) 2023-2027 with Ministry of Home Affair (MOHA); Entrepreneurship Action Plan - Higher Education Institutions (EAP-HEIs) 2021-2025 and New Funding Model for Public Universities with Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE); and National Waqf Plan 2021-2030 with Malaysian Wagf Foundation.

With the industry, ARI has produced some "early-win" research output. For example, through a smart collaboration with the Malaysian Institute of Integrity (IIM), ARI has developed an instrument which measures corporate integrity at workplaces. To date, organizations that have successfully used the instrument include Indah Water Konsortium (IWK) Sdn. Bhd., Celcom Berhad, and many more.

A study on the "Supply and Local Market for Producers, Marketers and Consumers of Fresh Agro-food" conducted in Selangor and Negeri Sembilan by the ARI experts help FAMA in reducing the risk of excess or cut-off supply along the supply chain of fresh agro-food. This in turn helps to restore the food supply chain through risk management in ensuring that the market continues to function so that the community can have food security. ARI has also built strong relationship with Association of Malaysian Statutory Bodies (PBBM).

Yearly, ARI is organizing series of trainings such as Governance, Management, and Leadership Training (GMLT); and Leadership, Entrepreneurial Development and Social Management Training (LEDSM) with PBBM.

ARI has forged various collaborations with international collaborators such as Seoul National University, South Korea; Burgas Free University, Bulgaria; Universitas Indonesia, Indonesia; United International University, Bangladesh; Institute of Public Enterprise, Hyderabad; The Human Security Institute, Pakistan; Ankara Medipol Universit, Turkiye to conduct research and conferences related to financial crime and money laundering. One yearly landmark conference co-organised by ARI with some of these agencies is the International Conference on Financial Criminology. The conference is generally attended by between 100 - 300 participants both at the national and international levels. Starting from 2021, ARI is organizing International Research Invention, Innovation and Exhibition (I-RIE) jointly with our local and international strategic partners. This virtual competition open to inventors and innovators across five (5) different categories including junior (aged 12 and below), young (aged 13 to 17), higher learning institutions (undergraduate and postgraduate), and open.

As part of our contribution to the community, ARI is actively organizing webinar series covering variety of topics including research methodologies, journal writing and publication, religious knowledge, motivational talks, and integrity. Each webinar is generally joined by more than 200 participants from Malaysia and overseas. ARI Fellows are also involved in providing motivational and integrity talks especially to those students sitting for Malaysian Certificate of Education (SPM) at secondary schools in Selangor.

They are also given opportunities to be involved in student exchange program and conferences either in Malaysia or abroad. ARI has developed a "Graduate on Time" postgraduate programme to support new students building their knowledge and skills to carry out independent research. Through GOT programme, the students are provided with supportive research environment via 22 different modules throughout their studies. Up to date, ARI has produced more than 30 graduates. Some were the recipients of the Research Excellence Award and achieving the Graduate-on-Time status. Years to come, ARI is targeting to become the Global Player in Islamic Financial Criminology.

In tandem with ARI's missions to enrich the knowledge corpus in the areas of Islamic Finance and Financial Criminology, ARI is offering four postgraduate programmes namely, Doctor of Philosophy (Islamic Finance & Muamalat), Doctor of Philosophy (Financial Criminology), Master of Science (Islamic Finance & Muamalat), and Master of Science (Financial Criminology). 12TH INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON FINANCIAL CRIMINOLOGY (ICFC) 2022


Accounting Research Institute (ARI), UiTM hosted the 12th International Conference Financial on Criminology (ICFC 2022) on 25th - 27th August 2022 held in a hybrid mode which is directly live from WYNG Gardens, Trinity Hall at University of Cambridge, United Kingdom, and also online mode via zoom meeting. ICFC 2022 has attracted almost 100 participants from Indonesia, Bangladesh, and various universities in Malaysia. However, there is also special participant from Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission, Association of Malaysian Statutory Bodies Malaysia. Thus, this conference has fantastic line-up speakers around the world, Prof. Dr. Rob Mccusker, Dr. Morrison Handley - Schachler (United Kingdom), Prof. John Blenkinsopp (England), Dr. Akinseye Olatakunbo Aluko, Dr. Peter Stiernstedt (London), Dr. Hendra Susanto (Indonesia), and Professor.
