UiTM Soars in 2024 QS World University Rankings by Subject

Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) achieves recognition in 18 subjects across four broad areas in the 2024 QS World University Rankings (WUR) by Subject. This marks the highest achievement in UiTM's history following its jump from 13 subjects that were ranked across three broad subject areas last year. This year, a total of 1,561 institutions have been ranked across 55 narrow subjects and five broad subject areas.

Among the most notable achievements this year is for Physics and Astronomy, which has been ranked for the first time in the university's history at 551-600. Education also finds itself ranked at 351-400 this year since it was last ranked three years ago. Similarly, Chemistry once again joined the ranks at 551-600 after it was last listed in 2021. In addition, seven subjects improved their rankings this year, which are Art and Design, Pharmacy and Pharmacology, Electrical Engineering, Business and Management Studies, Economics and Econometrics, Mechanical, Aeronautical and Manufacturing Engineering, and Computer Science and Information Systems.

Meanwhile, Hospitality and Leisure Management maintains its prestigious Top 100 position, and Petroleum Engineering remains among the Top 150 globally. Art and Design has made a significant leap, from 240 last year to now ranked among the Top 200 subjects worldwide. UiTM's multidisciplinary strengths are evident in subjects such as Architecture/Built Environment, Accounting and Finance, Law, Chemical Engineering, Agriculture and Forestry, and Medicine, further underscoring its comprehensive academic portfolio. As UiTM continues its journey, the university remains committed to delivering high-quality education and research that makes a meaningful impact on society.
