ABSTRACT

project paper presents a performance of Malaysia's Balance of Trade (BOT) as well as the external trade * for the past 15 years (1979-1993). It encompasses the performance of exports, imports, major trading partners and direction of The study shows that Malaysia performed trade. well in external trade. For the same 15 years period, manufacturing sector has grown rapidly as a result of increased imports from trading partners especially Japan. In the second part of the study, various factors affecting Balance of Trade by using regression examined (Malaysia) were analysis. It was found that income, money supply, inflation, GDP and previous year's Balance of Trade (BOT) were not significant in explaining the Balance of Trade (BOT). It means that there are other factors might influence the Balance of Trade risk.# exchange foreign such as (BOT)
